The 4nd Exam for awarding the **European Diploma in Transplant Medicine** is organised by the European Board of Transplant Medicine of the Division of Transplantation of the UEMS in collaboration with the European Society of Organ Transplantation (ESOT).

Application starts April 1st, 2015 and is opened for both

Junior and Senior transplant physicians

Junior candidates

Junior transplant physicians should have a minimal 2-year training in transplantation medicine for applying.

Juniors should apply for the Common Transplantation Medicine Module together with one or more of the Organ Modules: Kidney, Pancreas, Heart, Lung, Liver and Intestinal/Multivisceral Transplantation.

Deadline for application is May 30th, 2015

Final examination of eligible candidates will take place in Brussels, Belgium

on September 12th, 2015, at 13.00-17.00.

Venue: Square - Brussels Meeting Centre, rue Mont des Arts - 1000 Bruxelles - Belgium

Senior candidates

Senior transplant physicians with at least 10 years of continuous experience as specialists practicing in formal nationally recognized posts are eligible to apply for an Honorary Diploma and be exempted of the examination.

Seniors can apply for the following modules: Kidney, Pancreas, Heart, Lung, Liver and Intestinal/Multivisceral Transplantation.

For Honorary Diploma, Deadline for application is September 15th, 2015
