New Working Group - DESCARTES

A new ERA-EDTA Working Group has been launched. The acronym DESCARTES (Developing Education Science and Care for Renal Transplantation in European States) best summarizes the activity and mission of this group. DESCARTES was officially recognized as an ERA-EDTA working group during the Autumn Association's Council meeting in 2011 with the specific purpose of developing educational activities (specifically on preemptive transplantation and living donation), as well as promoting and developing both clinical and biological research in the field of kidney transplantation. DESCARTES is currently prospecting the possibility to start a controlled clinical multicenter trial focusing on optimizing the immunosuppression for elderly transplant patients. The background for such a study is the increasing number of elderly transplant candidates who only seldom have been the focus of clinical trials in the past.
