ERA-EDTA has launched a new ComIA initiative - ComIA Fellowship. ERA-EDTA is willing to sponsor long term, or short term, fellowships each year for young investigators and clinicians living in developing countries who, according to the current ERA-EDTA fellowship regulations, would otherwise not be able to participate in the regular ERA-EDTA fellowship programme.

These special fellowships are for investigators/clinicians living in developing countries outside Europe (or countries bordering Europe and the Mediterranean Sea).

All fellowships must be performed in Europe, or bordering countries, and at the end of the training the fellow must return to his/her country of origin.

Deadline for ComIA Clinical Fellowships' applications is **September 30, 2013**.
