New contributions from the ERA-EDTA Immunonephrology Working Group



The ERA-EDTA Immunonephrology Working Group is happy to announce the recent publication of the a study on the newly discovered risk loci for IgA nephropathy implicate genes involved in immunity against intestinal pathogens. This is by far the largest genome-wide association study (GWAS) of IgA nephropathy in 20,612 European and East Asian patients (1) identified six new significant genome-wide associations (in the genes ITGAM-ITGAX, VAV3, CARD9, HLA-DQB1 and DEFA) and replicated the previously identified signals.
