EU launched project to evaluate effectiveness and costs of ESRD treatment modalities

Good news: The European Union has taken a vital interest in evaluating the treatment modalities for patients with end stage renal disease (ESRD) in respect of effectiveness and costs – and initiated a new program: On 1 January of this year the EDITH project started, which is funded by the 3rd Health Programme of the European Union. The acronym stands for “The Effect of Differing Kidney Disease Treatment Modalities and Organ Donation and Transplantation Practices on Health Expenditure and Patient Outcomes” – and the project aims to examine the effect of differing kidney disease treatment modalities, organ donation and transplant practices on health expenditure and patient outcomes.
