

Discuss a novel therapeutic target for fibrosis on the NDT Educational blog



The Young Nephrology Platform (YNP) and NDT Educational have launched an initiative to discuss hot topics in nephrology. Now a stimulating article on interstitial renal fibrosis has been published by Rafael Kramann. He points out that fibrosis has been overlooked for many years, although 50% of all deaths in the industrialized world are associated with fibrotic disease. Kramann indicates that the Hedgehog transcriptional activator Gli1 might be responsible for kidney fibrosis and, thus, represents a novel therapeutic target.
