- Only application from couples, a urologist and a nephrologist, <u>from the same hospital</u> will be considered.
- Participating should be less than 45 yrs old.
- They should have a stable position in their hospital. This does not mean having a tenure position, but a contract of at least few years (4-5) in front for allowing they work together for a sufficiently long period.
- Thus, we will not admit trainees since they can move in different hospital at the end of their training.
- Attendants will be fully covered by Fondazione Menarini, Milan.
- We expect to receive the application by February 28 from each couple with their CVs and a
 declaration of the corresponding heads of department attesting the position of the
 applicants.
